
Lancashire Science Festival Code of Behaviour



Visiting campus will be very different from your experiences at school. The University's aim is that all students benefit from the visit and enjoy this new experience. To do this, you will be expected to show responsible behaviour while on campus as well as respect the rights of other students and staff.

Rules and regulations

For health and safety reasons, the following rules and regulations will be in operation:

- Students are expected to attend all timetabled activities.
- Students are not allowed to leave the campus and will always be supervised by Student Ambassadors or school staff.
- Students are expected to follow any emergency procedure, such as a fire drill, as directed by Student Ambassadors and staff.

- Treat all others regardless of race, gender, and disability with courtesy. The University does not tolerate bullying or harassment of any kind including verbal abuse.
